Emerald Ash Borer Information

Emerald Ash Borers have been confirmed in increasing numbers throughout Inverness and Barrington.

Check any Emerald Ash trees for signs of infestation which include:

- Metallic green beetles about half the diameter of a penny on or around ash trees
- Thinning and yellowing leaves
- D-shaped holes in the bark of the trunk or branches
- Shoots growing from the tree's base

HALLOWEEN SAFETY

Trick or Treat Hours

3:00–7:00 pm on Wednesday, October 31st

-  Discuss the importance of staying together in a group. Know which friends your children will be with and which route they will be taking.
-  Have an adult or responsible teenager accompany children when they go door-to-door.
-  Inspect all candy before your child consumes it. Avoid candy not wrapped in original wrapper and look for signs of tampering.
-  Avoid costumes that could cause children to trip, such as baggy pants, long hems, high heels and over-sized shoes.
-  Remember, using face paint makes it easier to see than wearing a mask.
-  Make sure costumes are visible at night. Add reflective tape to the costume so your child is more visible to motor vehicles.
-  Leave your porch light on so children will know it is OK to visit your home.
